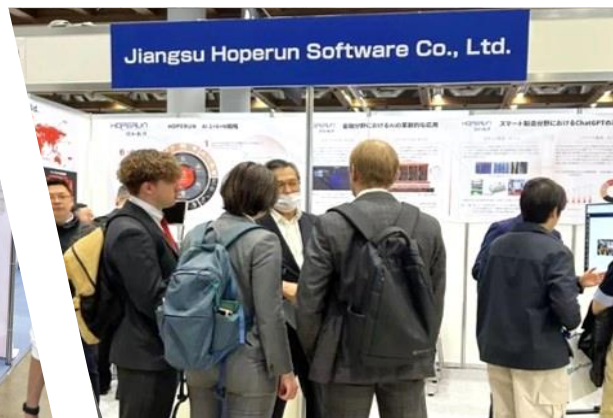
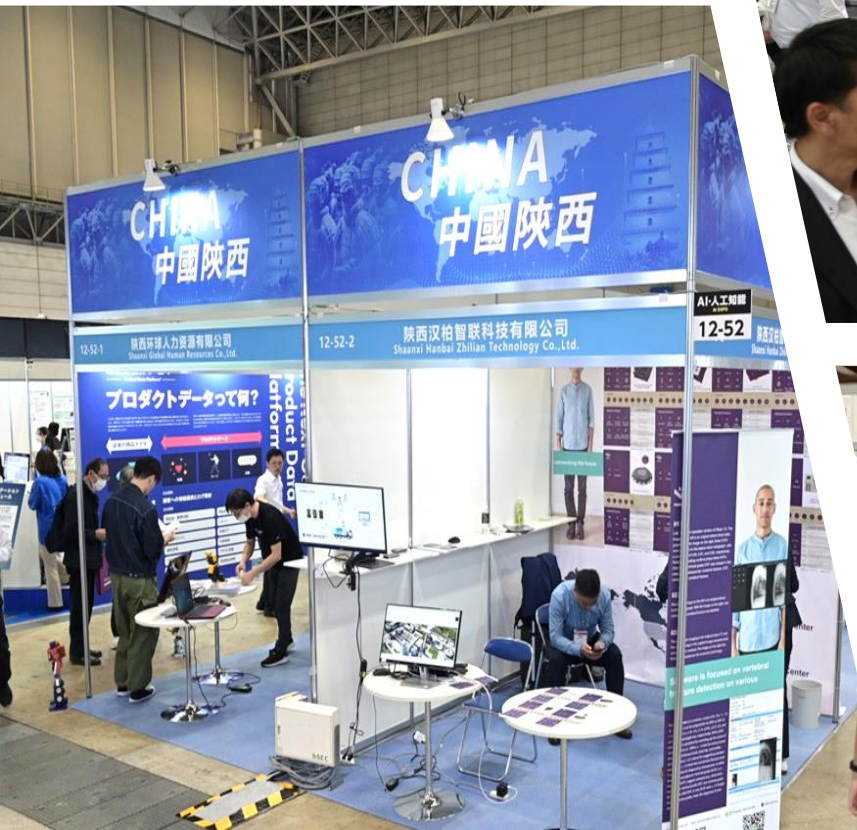
International Pavilions

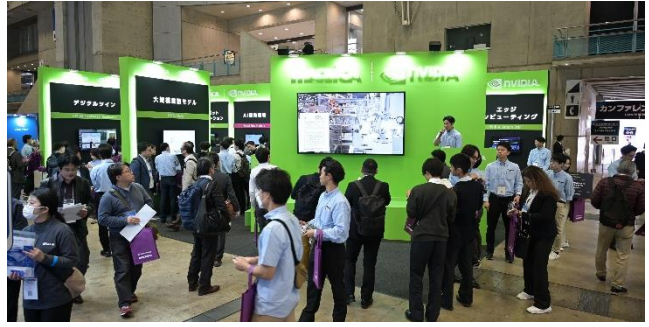
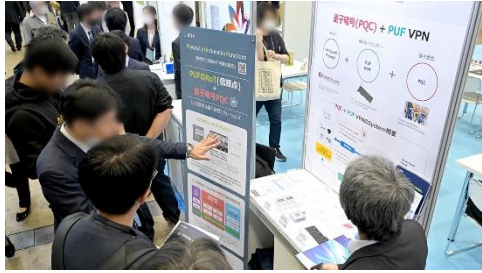
